The winning students are given awards by eminent dignitaries such as Hon'ble President, Hon'ble Prime Minister, etc., in the Government of India in a function organized on 14th December every year which is celebrated as National Energy Conservation Day

School Level – 14th OCT 2024.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1) Students of 5th, 6th & 7th class/standard are eligible to participate in Group 'A'.
- 2) Students of 8th, 9th & 10th class/standard are eligible to participate in Group 'B'.

Common Topics for category A (5th, 6th & 7th) & Category B (8th, 9th & 10th standard)

- **Conserve energy, Protect Environment** / ऊर्जा का संरक्षण, पर्यावरण का अनुरक्षण
- **Energy Saving is Environment Saving** / ऊर्जा की बचत पर्यावरण की रक्षक हैं

- 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize winners of States / UT Level Painting Competition each of Group 'A' and 'B' would be eligible to participate in National Level Painting Competition.
- The National Level Painting Competition of 2 hours duration would be held separately for Group 'A' and 'B'.
- The topics of the National Painting Competition for both groups shall be provided on the spot by BEE

- Other Terms & Conditions and General Instructions
 - (i) Students who have won either 1st or 2nd or 3rd prize during State / National Level Painting 2021 or 2022 or 2023 within the Group are not eligible to participate in the competition at any level of competition.
 - (ii) However, 1st or 2nd or 3rd prize winners of Group A can participate in Group B, if eligible.
 - (iii) The type of materials that can be used are Pencil, Color Pencil, Crayon and Water Color.
- The 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners of State/UT level Painting Competition shall not draw same or similar painting at National Level and if found so, such painting may be disqualified.
- The State / UT level competition is to be organized on 14th November 2024
